Remember, to be accepted by the Australian Electoral Commission, nominators must be registered to vote in Queensland with their details listed exactly as they appear on the electoral roll. If in doubt, you can check your enrollment at <https://check.aec.gov.au/> or by calling 13 23 26.

Once the election is called, expect a call from the AEC as they'll need to check the authenticity of your nomination.
